What is Courseware?

Material that students access on the publisher's site (with or without an access code)

What are the different types of courseware?

- **eBook:** Material that students access on the RedShelf eReader
- **Coded Product:** Material that students access with a code on the publisher's site
- **Codeless Product:** Material that students access on the publisher's site without using an access code

How do you access courseware?

eBooks:

Students access their eBook on the *RedShelf eReader*, which is embedded within the LMS. Students can opt-out of eBook access.

Courseware:

Students can access their courseware in one of two ways, depending on the course materials manager's preference.

- With *codeless access*, students access their courseware via the publisher's link in the LMS. This is facilitated by RedShelf without the need to log into the publisher's environment or enter an access code. Students can opt-out of access, and billing reports are provided to the campus store.
- Alternatively, RedShelf can provide students with courseware *access codes*, which they use to access courseware on the publisher's site.
